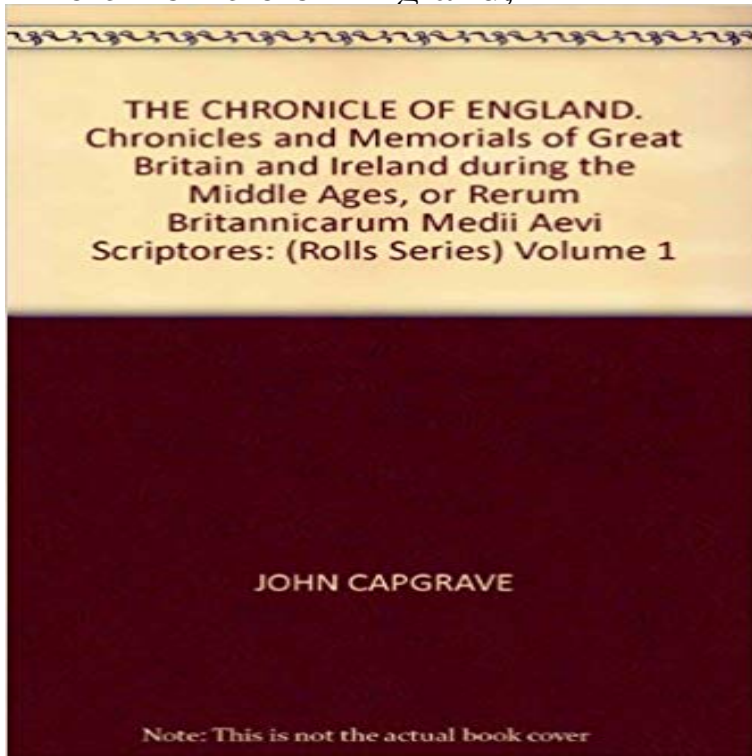


The chronicle of England,
